<b>3.4 La Reserve</b>		
<b>3.4.1 Port &amp; Channel</b>	Injury	No persons allowed to swim in port or channel. Buoyed channel. Speed limit 5 knots in & out of channel. Equipment not launched into channel.
<b>3.4.2 Slipway / Launching &amp; Recovery</b>	Injury	Caution when removing equipment from port as slippery. Use correct trolleys and trailers for equipment, with safe operating and handling procedures.
<b>3.4.3 Public Pontoon</b>	Injury	Staff & Pupils NOT to walk on public pontoon to get to Rockley Beach.
<b>3.4.4 Duck Huts</b>	Injury	Remain safe distance from, as under water obstructions not easily seen. Fleet control by instructors.
<b>3.4.4 Oil Rig Platforms</b>	Injury	Keep a safe distance, some in operation. Safety Talk. Fleet control by instructors. Fleet control by instructors.
<b>3.4.5 "Everglades"</b>	Injury	Speed limit 5 knots, no access to powerboats for certain dates to preserve wildlife.
<b>3.4.6 Military Zone</b>	Injury	Restricted Area. No landing on other side of lake by any craft. Fleet control by instructors.
<b>3.4.7 Ski Zone</b>	Injury	Buoyed area present for skiing near land opposite Rockley Beach. Operating area to be kept clear. Safety Talk. Awareness of staff to ski boats travelling to and from area. Fleet control by instructors.
